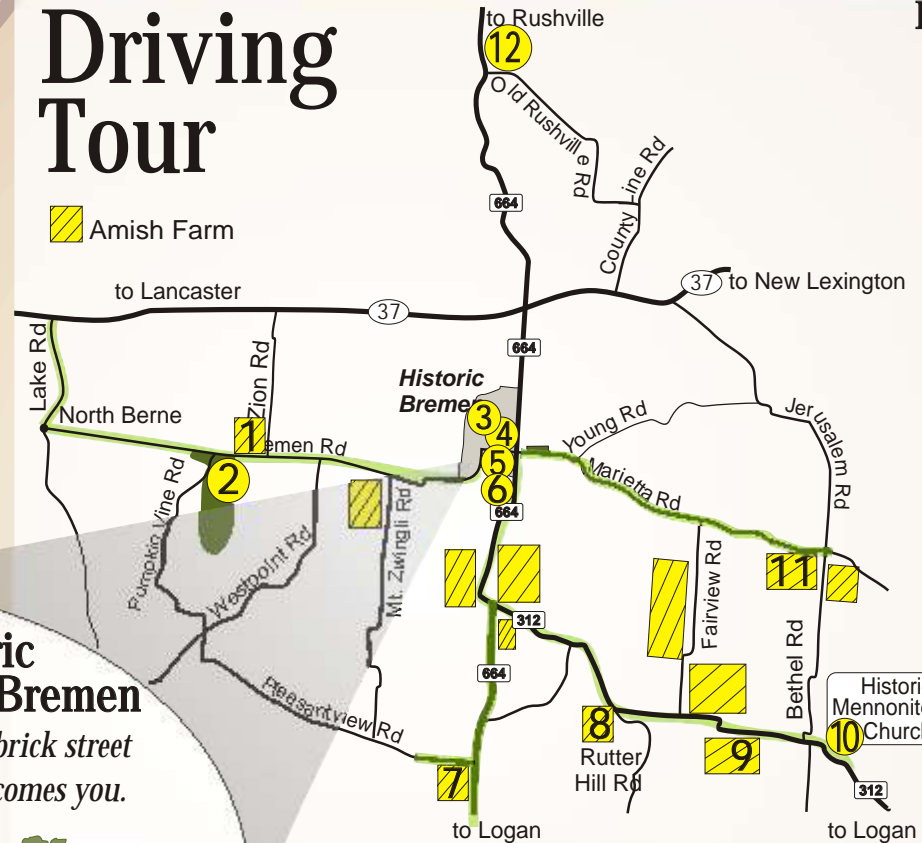


Amish of Rushcreek Township, Ohio

Rushcreek Township is home to a growing community of "old order" Amish. They live a centuries old, plain lifestyle where the horse and buggy remain a primary form of transportation.

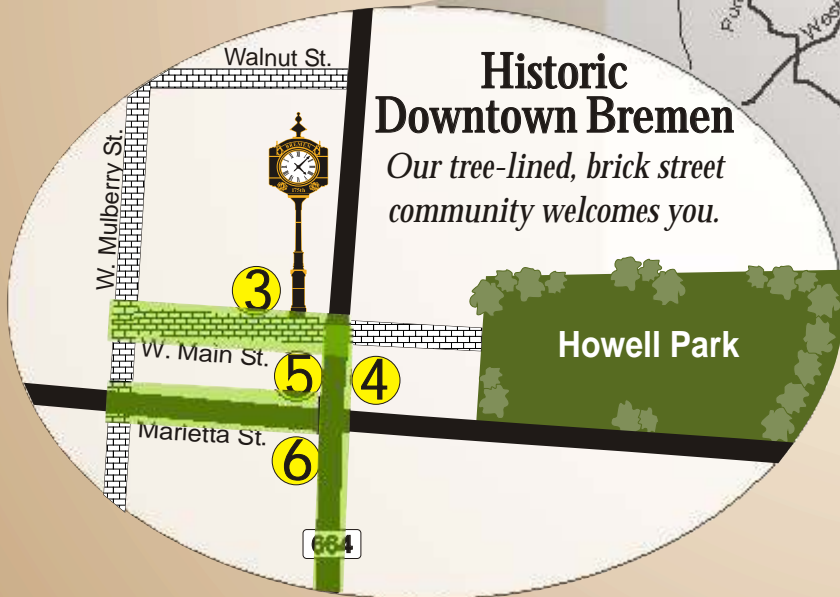
