

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All vendors must register with the Bremen Bank Market Master. Registration fees may be paid on or before the day the market starts. The fee per space at the market is \$10.00.
2. Farmers are to sell what they produce; no dock or warehouse produce is permitted. We allow homemade baked goods, cheese, jams, salsa, honey, soap, lotion, etc., provided that the processed foods have met all the state and local regulations.
3. The Market Master will assign places to vendors. These locations are usually the width of a parking spot. Tables are **NOT** provided.
4. Set-up begins at 8:00 AM on the day of the market. Market hours run from 9:00am - Noon each Saturday beginning May 17th through September 20th...**RAIN OR SHINE**.
5. Each vendor's display must not impede pedestrian traffic on the sidewalk or street nor impede vehicular traffic.
6. Vendors are responsible to set their own prices and provide their own rain gear.
7. No loud radios or shouting of prices are permitted.
8. Electricity and refrigeration are **NOT** available at the market.
9. Vendors are to clean their areas, removing all produce, containers, signs, and trash at the end of the market day or when they leave.
10. Grievances or problems are to be directed to the Market Master for resolution. The Market Master makes final decisions on disputes.
11. It is the vendor's responsibility to obtain all the licenses and permits and to pay the fees required by local and state governing bodies. This includes the vendor's license for goods sold for which a sales tax must be collected.
12. Vendors must comply with all law ordinances and regulations of the United States, State of Ohio, and Village of Bremen.
13. The sale of live animals, flea market items, and foods that are prepared on the premises (i.e., concession-stand types of foods) are **NOT PERMITTED**. HOWEVER, there is one exception to this rule: a business storefront located in the downtown.
14. Your Market Masters are all **unpaid** VOLUNTEERS. Please treat them kindly. They are here to help us all succeed.
15. Horses are to be parked in designated areas.
