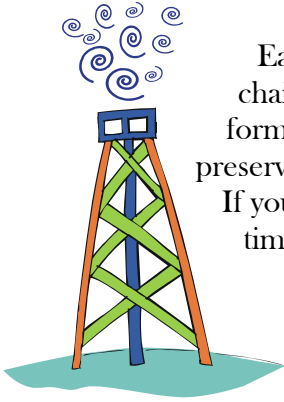

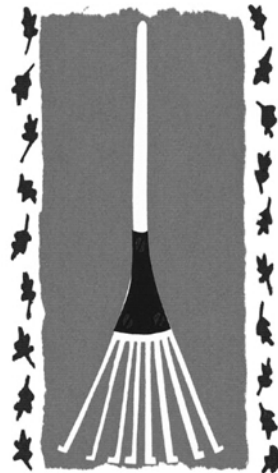
Winter is Coming!
