## Siren Signals



While this isn't the time of year that we normally think about tornadoes, it seems that we need to be thinking along those lines. With a fairly quiet spring and summer, many of us were caught unawares by the recent tornado sirens and couldn't quite remember what it all meant. Just to remind you, the tornado siren has a definite pattern.

The warning signal is a 3 minute steady signal from the firehouse siren. It is followed by 7 minutes of quiet. This cycle is repeated until the threat is gone. When the danger is past, the siren will sound a 1 minute "all clear" to let you know. When you hear the siren, please pay attention and seek shelter. The siren is set off by outside agencies which are monitoring weather conditions.
