High Water Issues

In the first 12 days of February the Village had over 6 inches of rainfall and many of our residents had water issues on their property or in their homes. Street Levy on the Ballot in 2019

It's no secret that the streets are in bad shape! The Village has been discussing for some time going on the ballot for a street levy and we are now preparing the paperwork to do so.

We need your support in order to pass the levy and repair our streets. Our current goal for the ballot is to ask for a 3 MIL levy for five years. This would generate approximately \$63,000 per year for the Village to begin repairing the streets.

The overall goal is not to just pave over the existing streets but to grind down and re-do the streets correctly. This is a time-consuming process and we are planning on doing one full street per year. Our goal is to show you that measures are being taken to improve the Village and keep it as nice as possible.
