THOUGHTS: In the last newsletter, Council asked for your input as to whether or not to put on the ballot the issue of alcohol sales. I have received 12 responses. I will give a final report to Council at our next meeting and really would like for you to weigh in with your thoughts before then. Council really desires your input so they can make the best decision for the Village. Putting something on the ballot takes a lot of work and necessary signatures. Parents: when you allow your children to come down to Howell Park, PLEASE direct them to use the sidewalk. We have already had a couple close calls with children riding their bikes out on Marietta Road instead of using the sidewalk. Please tell your kids!!!

Drivers: with the break in the weather, please drive with greater caution. Kids are on their bikes and scooters and they tend to not watch for traffic as closely as they should. Be aware of what is going on around you. Please stay within the posted speed limits and slower.

By the time you receive this newsletter, ODOT will be starting to grind and pave Route 664 from Rushville through Bremen to the Hocking County line. They are also doing Route 312 from Route 664 all the way down to Route 93 just outside of Logan. During this time please observe all signage and traffic directions. Plan for extra time due to stopped traffic. Because of the close timeline, I have put off paving Angle St. until ODOT is through the village with their paving. Be safe and let the state workers do their job without fear of vehicles infringing on their safety. You might consider using Bremen Road out through North Berne and over to Route 37 or Marietta Road out to Jerusalem Road depending on the direction you need to travel.

SWIMMING POOL NEWS: The base for the new diving board is in place and we are ready to bolt down the new structure. This brings the village into compliance with current regulations as to height and distance allowed for diving boards. It is also our wish to replace the concrete around the baby pool but I am not sure we will be able to do that this year. A lot depends on the weather and whether the village workers have time.

OPENING DAY AT THE SWIMMING POOL WILL BE SATURDAY, MAY 24TH. IT WILL ALSO BE "FREE DAY". THE POOL WILL BE OPEN SUNDAY AND MONDAY OF MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND BUT WILL NOT OPEN AGAIN UNTIL SATURDAY, MAY 31ST DUE TO SCHOOL STILL BEING IN SESSION. THE POOL OPENS AT 12:00 NOON EACH DAY. PHONE: 740-438-8170

PARENTS: Your child MUST HAVE FINISHED 4TH GRADE to be able to swim alone at the Bremen Pool. If they are not beyond 4th grade then they need to have a babysitter who is at least 16 years old or accompanied by a parent. There are no exceptions!

The pool has a new LIFT CHAIR for those with special needs who must have help getting in or out of the water. The weight limit is 250 pounds. I will caution all kids and parents by saying this is not something to be played on. Kids making poor choices will be set out for a time out or if repeated problems exist... could be expelled from the pool for a period of time. No bullying... no fighting... no foul language... no inappropriate behaviors!!!

Go to the Fairfield County Auditor's website or stop by their office in the Fairfield County Courthouse. More than 10,500 homeowners in Fairfield County were enrolled in this program last year. Those homeowners saw a reduction in their annual real estate taxes by an average of more than \$350.00. AS WE BEGIN MOWING GRASS... Please <u>DO NOT BLOW YOUR GRASS</u> into the street. When you blow the grass into the street the grass is washed into the catch basins causing a matting of the grass and subsequent clog that blocks the storm sewer line.

YES – BREMEN HAS A CURFEW: If you are under the age of 18 you must be off the streets between the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am. Our Sheriff Deputy will enforce this curfew and there will be legal consequences should a child under 18 be caught out on the street. If you are 16 and older and coming home from work in a vehicle, you will be excused upon showing proof of where you work and can show you are in fact headed home.

The RESTROOMS IN HOWELL PARK will be open by May 1st or sooner. The village workers are working on the facilities as I write this. They will be opened in the morning and locked in the evening. Also, remember when on the playground at Howell Park or over around the village buildings, YOU ARE ON CAMERA and we see you before you see us. Please pick up your trash and dispose it properly in our many trash cans throughout the Park...

PET OWNERS: your dog must be on a leash at all times when in the park. Please bring your own pet-waste baggy or use one found in the boxes around the walking path. Please keep our Park in a sanitary condition and by doing so show your respect for others in the Park.

NOW IS THE TIME TO RESERVE THE SHELTER HOUSE... On the weekends we provide the shelter house for a lunch slot 11:00 – 4:00 and a dinner slot from 4:30 to dusk. It is important to do this so more families can take advantage of the shelter house. Please call Fran at 569-4788 to reserve the facilities and to get the fees involved for using electric and the concession stand as well as the CONTRACT that expresses the village's expectations.

The Village has numerous projects that we can use some help with. In order to come into compliance with our insurance policy we need to do some repair work on the play equipment and add pea gravel in the existing area as well as an area where play equipment sits on the grass. This month will be the anniversary of my coming to Bremen as your administrator. As I start my fourth year, I am pleased with the progress the village is making. Our infrastructure is improving each year. We are fortunate to have received the grant monies that we have.

Since my coming the village has accomplished or is in the process of accomplishing:

- The Storm Separation Trunk Line at a cost of \$500,000. \$300,000 in grant money. Our Water and Waste Water team continues the Storm / Sanitary separation work on our own saving the village several MILLION dollars by doing the project as we are able instead of outsourcing the work.
- New Curbs and Gutters and repositioning of the bricks on Fort St. at a cost of \$268,00 This was an OPWC Grant.
- New sidewalk from downtown to Howell Park with Marten's Trust at a cost of \$12,500.
- All new pumps and electrical updates at the Waste Water Treatment Plant at a cost of \$75,000.00.
- Established a working relationship with Rushville whereby we now do all their Utility Billing which brings \$11,000.00 of revenue to the village. We are also working on other projects which will benefit Bremen and Rushville.
- Block Grants that provided new Handicap Ramps for \$39,600.00 on Marietta St. Major renovations and beautification of Howell Park with a special thank you to
 - David and Debbie Wolfe and village workers.
- New Curbs and Gutters and in-kind labor to reposition the bricks coming for Strayer Ave. starting this summer for \$168,000 with our OPWC Grant.
- In 2015 2016 Safe Routes to School Grant. We have already been awarded a grant of \$340,000 for sidewalks, cross walks, signage, and flashers on Strayer and Angle Streets.
- Just our Grant projects have a total value in excess of \$1,338,000.00. This is a great accomplishment between grant monies and the village's in-kind labor and minor financial contributions. The other monies the village has spent show fiscal responsibility to extend the tax payer's money.

This is just a list of major projects while much, much more is accomplished on a day to day basis with the work of our village workers.
