We have a great Mayor and Council, a great Committee on Financial Process, and a great Clerk-Treasurer. Together we will work hard to keep the Village on the best fiscal path and use the resources entrusted to us in the best way. Thank you for putting your trust in these elected persons. They do serve the Village well and have the best interest of the Village at heart. Thank you for supporting them in their hard work and hard decisions. They deserve your support and respect. Don't forget... the Village Council meeting on August 12th at 7:00 pm will be held at the Bremen Elementary School cafetorium. We will have Randy Comisford from ODOT to talk to all concerning the award of \$340,000 for the Safe Routes To School Project. He will share what the monies will go toward and answer any questions. This is a great accomplishment from the BESAFFE Committee and the Village. Our children will be protected and have a much safer walkway to and from school. This is the first phase of what could be many additional work projects through Safe Routes To School to help our children. If you are a parent of a child(ren) who walk or bike to school, you are encouraged to attend.

I have received a few calls about mosquitoes. We always contract with Terminex. Usually we spray once a month but I added an additional spraying at the end of July and will do it again in August if warranted. The rain in June and July aggravated the situation. Please look around and make sure there are no containers holding water which is a mosquitoes' breeding ground. Also check your gutters that may be holding water.

Hopefully, soon, we will be working on potholes and trimming limbs in the alleys. Just haven't got to them yet... If the rear of your house is on an alley and has limbs hanging over the alley and you can cut them off, please do so. If you can help... thanks in advance!!!
