Bidding for the Dowling Park Project

Village of Bremen, is accepting sealed bids for Landscape Improvements in Dowling Park, as described in the Contract Documents. Generally, the project involves installation of horizontal interlocking unit pavers, ground anchors for future benches and tables, and cultured stone veneer on pavilion columns.

The deadline for bids to be received is 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, August 8, 2018. Bids will be opened at 11:15 a.m. on that same day, at the Village of Bremen municipal building.

Contract award shall be made based on the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The Village reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, and to accept any bid which it deems to be in the best interest of the Village.
