Volunteers Dan Rutherford and Kye Cook have already been helping with various projects at the park. In addition, Barb Johnson dead-heads the marigolds at the concession stand, and Fred Sherlock pulls weeds at the old fountain area in Dowling Park. Furthermore, when we recently needed special signs, Mike Qualls of Gene's Signs was gracious enough to make and donate them to the park. These individuals deserve a sincere thank-you for stepping up to the plate and helping in so many ways.



If you haven't been to the park lately, you need to come and see the butterflies arriving daily and the cascade of flowers.

As for the garden pond, it is still in the process of being finished. When we get the final permanent fencing in place, this will be a place where you can sit down on a bench and enjoy the scenery and sounds of the

gurgling water. It is not meant to be a place where children can climb on the rocks and run around the pond. Because the rocks are only "dry stacked" it is not safe for children to be running on them.

Finally, we would greatly appreciate assistance in completing a few park projects. One is we would like to find a licensed electrician who would donate their time to perform a couple electrical jobs. Also, financial donations would be appreciated so we can finish the fence around the pond. Since the pond was not part of the park budget, my husband and I have paid for the materials and equipment for this park feature. The butterfly garden, which has been dubbed "A Patch of Paradise", is registered as a Certified Waystation for Monarch butterflies. The monarchs have recently started making their seasonal appearance to the flowers in the park. Don't miss the opportunity to stop by and take a break at the flower garden and pond!
