This vacancy occurred on September 12, 2016. In accordance with ORC 731.43, Village Council has 30 days from the date of the vacancy to appoint a replacement. If Council does not appoint a replacement, then the Mayor shall appoint the replacement.

The next regular Council meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 10th and the new council member could be appointed at that time.
