#### Leaf Collection

The annual daunting task of leaf collection is underway. Due to the sheer volume of leaves during the peak of the season, it's not possible for the village's crew to cover the entire town each week. They will, however, try to alternate between two halves of the town on a weekly basis. So please be patient if they don't get to your location immediately.

Leaves to be collected should be piled behind the curb, not in the gutter or street. Leaves in streets can clog storm sewer drains and lead to high water problems as well as costly maintenance problems.

#### Village Finances

Hello, Citizens! I am Jennifer Storey, your Clerk-Treasurer, and I would like to talk to you today about accounting. Yes, accounting, fun for all the boys and girls!

As more of you have become involved with the Village, I've noticed there is some confusion about how the Village accounts are set up, so I am going to go over some details for you.

- 1. There is only one Village bank account. The separate 'funds' are only maintained in the accounting software that Bremen uses.
- 2. If money is specified for a particular purpose, by law it cannot be used for anything else. If you want to donate money to the Pool, for example, I would deposit the money into the bank account and then log a receipt into the Pool Fund in the software. That is where the money would stay until we spend it on Pool needs.
- 3. The Village did not take money out of the Pool fund to use for storm damage. Every year, there is money transferred from the General Fund to the Pool Fund for operations and salaries. This year, that money did not transfer into the Pool Fund and therefore was available for us to use as needed.
